

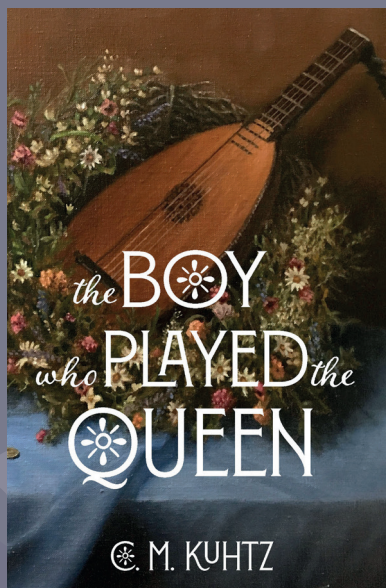

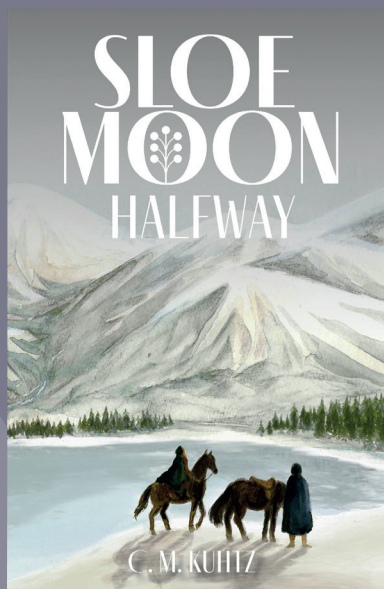
Two young men meet by chance among the hustle and bustle of a city in which their true desires are punishable by death.

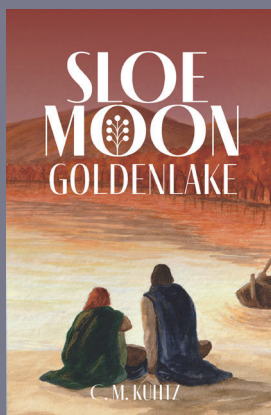
